

Professionals of vision from around Europe to meet in Helsinki next year

The European Academy of Optometry and Optics (EAOO) will be organising its annual international conference in Helsinki 15–17 May 2020. Organised for the first time in Finland, as many as 500 professionals in the field of vision and eyecare from all around Europe are expected to attend.

The main theme of the event is the future of optometry and optometrists. Interesting speakers and an extensive programme are in store for professionals in all areas of the field.

The Finnish Association of Vision and Eyecare (NÄE ry) will be hosting the Helsinki2020 event, the arrangements for which are well under way. The customary NÄE training days will also be held in connection with the main event, and therefore no training will be offered in January next year.

Established in 2009, the European Academy of Optometry and Optics (EAOO) is an umbrella organisation for research and training in the field of vision within the European Union. The purpose of the organisation is to advocate for the audibility of the shared voice of professionals in the field of optometry and optics, develop and support the foundations for field-related research and promote the continuous development of professional expertise among optometrists, opticians and other professionals in the field of vision and eyecare around Europe.
